This is a unique opportunity to study calligraphy and related book arts with master instructors. Applicants will live in campus dormitories, gather for meals and enjoy evening programs. Travel expenses, supplies and other incidentals are not included.

The scholarship is non-transferable, if the recipient is unable to attend, the award reverts back to the Scholarship Committee.
